Hollywood Hills once owned by boxer Jack
Dempsey. During the renovation process he
discovered a new passion in home design,
one that would inspire a new profession.

Dalinger Designs specializes in unique home renovation projects, from ironwork to woodwork to unique finishes. But unlike other specialists in this area, Jorge's company offers something special – an old-world craftsmanship-meets-modern functionality that produces spectacular results.

With partner Master carver Paco Luis, Jorge shares a workshop in southern Spain near Granada where they make hand-carved coffered ceilings for an exclusive clientele. Their traditional Moorish woodworking techniques have been handed down for centuries in the region and make for breathtaking visual art in the home. Dalinger Designs also woodworks furniture, doors, cabinets and floors and manufactures hand forged ironworks, such as gates, railings and lighting.

Currently, the team is at work on a variety of homes, including the first to ever be featured by Architectural Digest in 1925.
